We will be using the money to help set up the new Young Carers Hub where children and young people can come together, share their experiences and enjoy enrichment activities.

Young Carers often lack the opportunities that their peers do and we felt that by providing a base for them, they can use the room as they wish, within reason. Some activities that will be in the Hub include weekly homework support, air hockey table and games, Lego and craft for the younger children. There will be an area for relaxation - and for young carers to access the internet or listen to music. We want the room to be as multifunctional as possible and with any funds we receive, this helps to purchase and maintain the resources the children and young people identify that they need.
